The lease options study team recommends we stay where we are and begin work now with the City of Renton to obtain a new long-term lease, rather than wait until 2018. We expect this will increase the value of our capital assets, and assure we have sufficient tiedown parking spaces for our aircraft. We should also look at upgrading our current BEFA facilities.

After the decline in the cost of fuel, it is now increasing slightly, and may continue to do so. Please take advantage of these lower rates while you can. This is a good time to work on an instrument rating.

We are now down to one C-150, 704RY; it's currently at KPAE. We are actively looking for a C-152.

The Board has decided to sell the Warrior as it costs more to maintain and has low use as a training aircraft. Many of us will be sorry to see it go.
