Check-ride Matrix

A pilot receives a 6 month check in an aircraft that is shaded blue. Provided the pilot has been checked out in – and – is current in the aircraft listed below the shaded aircraft, the pilot is qualified to fly to all aircraft below.

Notes:

- 1.) The float plane can be used to satisfy land plane requirements once every 12 months.
- 2.) The Cirrus is considered "special" in that no other aircraft can be used to satisfy its requirements.
- 3.) Retractable gear aircraft require a check out every 6 months.
- 4.) "C182" is the fixed-gear 182
- 5) 172SP's Initial checkout required for fuel injection and autopilot.
- 6) GTN650 Equipped aircraft requirements:
 - a) VFR Operations: CFI signoff with ground checkout. (CFI's can self train & checkout)
 - b) IFR Operations: CFI signoff with flight checkout. (Applies to ALL pilots.)

5.2.2.1 Make and Model

- a) All members who are rated pilots must have a make and model check-ride in each model prior with a BEFA CFI prior to acting as P.I.C. in that model.
- b) The first check ride at BEFA for a new member must be given by a BEFA CFI designated as a Check Pilot.
